Most of us know of Manna House, a homeless-prevention charity that serves over 7,000 free lunches a year, holds over 700 housing and benefits appointments and engages in over a thousand one-to-one support sessions, plugging the gaps left by mainstream health and social care services. However, like many charities nowadays, Manna House is in severe financial crisis, having to support an ever-increasing number of homeless people. Next month, it will have to cut staff hours for the first time in 15 years, resulting in reduced services, fewer people supported and more crises coming to boiling point.
