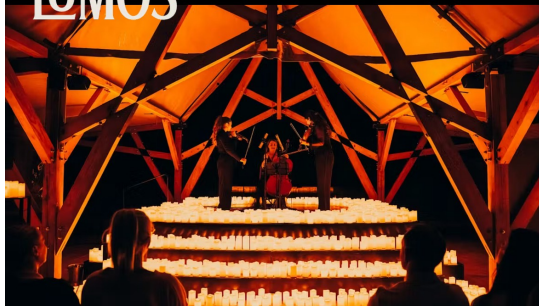

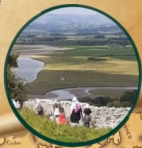

I've recently had
to give up work
due to a back
injury and I'm
worried about

**how I'm going to cope with the drop in income.
I'm not sure what benefits I can get - where
should I start?**

To get started, you can use an online benefits calculator, using the details of your current income and expenditure, which will provide a quick idea of what benefits and other financial help you might be eligible for.

The main benefit available for most people of working age over 18 is Universal Credit if you have less than £16,000 in savings. If you're finding it difficult to work because of your injury, you might get more Universal Credit or not have to look for work. Inform the Department for Work and Pensions that you have a health condition when you claim and submit a fit note.

You might be entitled to other benefits. Disability benefits such as Personal Independence Payment aren't means-tested. You may also be entitled to the new-style Employment and Support Allowance (ESA). If you pay council tax, you might be able to get a reduction in your bill. There is also help available if you still don't have enough money to live on, from the government, your local council or a charity.

You can get information on all these topics on the Citizens Advice website. And if you're still not sure, remember you don't have to face this alone – contact South Lakes Citizens Advice. Our advisers can help to check what benefits and financial support you might be entitled to, and help you find a way forward.

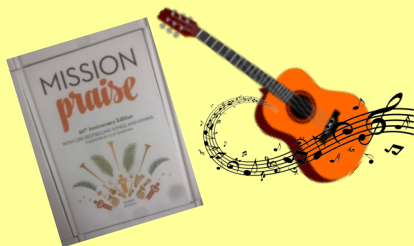

Dear Friends,

A recent survey discovered that 40% of adults in England did not believe that Jesus was a real historical figure, that he was a mythological figure found only in the writings of the early Christians.

Surprisingly for someone who lived in an obscure part of the Roman Empire, there is historical evidence for Jesus outside the pages of the New Testament. Within a few decades of his lifetime, he is mentioned by Jewish and Roman historians. This contrasts strongly with a mythological figure like King Arthur, first referred to 300 or 400 years after he is supposed to have lived. The evidence for Jesus is not limited to later folklore, as are accounts of Arthur.

Tacitus and Pliny the Younger were Roman figures who mentioned Jesus in those early decades. Neither liked Christians – Pliny describes their “pig-headed obstinacy” and Tacitus calls their religion a destructive superstition. But the earliest record we have of Jesus outside the Bible is the Jewish historian Flavius Josephus, who wrote a history of Judaism around AD93.

He mentions Jesus twice. One is a reference to James, the brother of ‘Jesus, the so-called Christ’. The other is a more indepth paragraph:

“About this time there lived Jesus, a wise man, [if indeed one ought to call him a man]. For he was one who wrought surprising feats and was a teacher of such people as accept the truth gladly. He won over many Jews and many of the Greeks. [He was the Messiah.] When Pilate, upon hearing him accused by men of the highest standing among us, had condemned him to be crucified, those who had in the first place come to love him did not give up their affection for him. [For he appeared to them alive again on the third day, the divine prophets having foretold these and countless other marvellous things about him.] And the tribe of the Christians, so called after him, has still to this day not disappeared.” This passage is not without controversy. The parts placed within [brackets] are disputed. The claim is that these words were not written by Josephus but by Christians who later altered the text to give it a blatant Christian spin. That has been a consensus amongst scholars for decades, that Josephus himself wrote a brief, neutral—or even negative—remark about Jesus, which was then ‘improved’ by a Christian scribe copying out Josephus’s works in a later century.

A challenge to this mainstream view was published last year by Thomas Schmidt, inviting a bit of rethinking on the matter. Examining the earliest manuscripts of Josephus, the frequency of phrases and the use of language, he argues that Josephus is recording first hand accounts from those who were at the trial of Jesus. Schmidt argues, Josephus moved within the priestly dynasty directly connected to Jesus’ death. He was not drawing on Christian rumour but on the recollections of Jerusalem leaders he knew personally. Schmidt would translate Josephus sentence about the resurrection as “it seemed to them that he was alive again.” - not a proclamation of the Christian message added later but a noncommittal or sceptical way of referencing what Christians believed.

Either way, there is ample reasonable evidence that Jesus lived in the first century, and that from the beginning Christians were saying that he rose from the dead. What we do with that evidence and how we explore further begin a much more interesting adventure

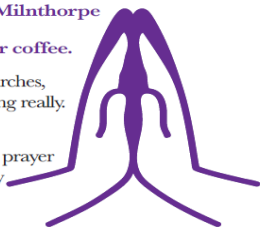

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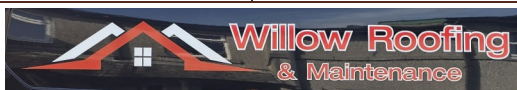
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
