

The Athenaeum is held in trust by Heversham and Leasgill Parish Council and is run by a small team of skilled, local volunteers who give their time and effort to operate and manage all aspects of the hall. Groups and individuals from throughout the area use the Athenaeum on a regular basis for sport, leisure, social and business purposes. Levens Village Hall - Notice of No Dogs policy

The trustees of LVH were recently made aware by Levens Parish Council of public concern regarding the health implications of dog fouling on the grass area at the back of the hall (which belongs to the hall).

This area is a play space for children using the hall. The trustees of the hall obviously have a responsibility for the safety and wellbeing of its users, and so after due consideration it was thought inappropriate to let dogs have access to this grass.

However, after further review, it was decided that for some months of the year the grass was unlikely to be used by children (certainly those using the hall) so the restriction will only be applied between 1st April and 30th September annually.

Whilst recognising people's frustration over this as the grass has been used by dog walkers for many years, the trustees consider it to be the right course of action and hope you will all support and abide by the new restriction (which is in line with many other children's play areas).

We did initially erect 2 'no dogs please, children play here' signs

Someone has removed the signs !

If you know who did this - please ask them to -

- return the signs to the hall
- &/or donate £40 to cover costs
- &/or volunteer as a Trustee and be part of the decision making and planning in the future, working for the benefit of the hall and community.

We plan to get more signs in order to keep the grass safe for children's use, and hope that our decision and actions are respected by all.

I saw a branded backpack at a really good price online, but when it arrived, it was thin plastic with fake logo patches. What can I do about it?

Citizens Advice are seeing a huge increase in cases of counterfeit goods being reported, bought both directly from traders and online. Beware of suspiciously low prices for branded goods. Sometimes sellers even argue the items were obviously fake because they were very cheap. But they're breaking the law by selling these items and your legal rights still apply.

You're legally entitled to a full refund on fake goods within 30 days of your purchase. If it's been over 30 days since you paid, but less than six months, the seller is allowed to give you a real version of the item. If they can't do this, they're legally required to give you a full refund. If you paid more than six months ago, you're only entitled to a part-refund based on how much you've used the item and how long you've had it.

If the seller refuses to give you a refund and you paid by debit card, contact your bank and ask to use the 'chargeback scheme'. If you paid by credit card and the item cost less than £100, you can use the same scheme. If you paid by credit card and the item cost between £100 and £30,000, tell your credit card company you want to make a 'section 75' claim. If you paid cash, contact the Citizens Advice Consumer Service. You can also report a seller to Trading Standards, which investigates criminal activity. Find out more on the Citizens Advice website.

Dear Friends,

The comic strip Dilbert satirised corporate culture, its scenes set in a micromanaged office where the title character was an engineer. First published in 1989, it was syndicated worldwide until a few years ago, when it was cancelled due to intemperate and unwelcome comments from its creator and illustrator, Scott Adams.

Scott Adams died recently, on 13th January. Even on his deathbed, he managed to court further controversy. During his last few weeks, Adams announced on social media that he was considering becoming a Christian. Even though he had been a lifelong atheist, he found himself drawn to Jesus's teachings, describing Christianity as 'uniquely compelling and morally grounding.'

Finally, he wrote the following: "I accept Jesus Christ as my lord and savior [sic], and I look forward to spending an eternity with him. The part about me not being a believer should be quickly resolved if I wake up in heaven. I won't need any more convincing than that."

This last statement inevitably aroused much heat and light on internet discussion forums. Was Scott Adams genuine in his new found faith, or was he cynically and selfishly using the salvation offered through Christ?

The short answer, and probably the wisest, is to advise that only God can look into the heart of the man, and we should leave the matter with him.

However, Scott Adams' statement about his faith is an old argument re-presented for the twenty-first century. In the 1600s, French philosopher Blaise Pascal expressed with a rational theory for trusting in God based on probability and outcome. It is known as Pascal's wager and put simply, states:

Either God exists or he does not. If he does not exist, then it does not matter whether one believes or doesn't. But if he does exist, you either believe and trust him, to your eternal advantage, or do not believe, to your eternal loss. Therefore, concludes Pascal, on the balance of probability and consequences, it is better to believe.

There is undoubtedly logic here, but I find it a mercenary and self-serving piece of argumentation. There are much better reasons for believing, trusting and loving God, supremely it forms the logical response to the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Yet thoughts like Pascal's may run through our minds at times, especially if the possibility of a deathbed conversion is available. We can live our lives how we wish, without the shame and sacrifice involved in following Christ daily, and then call upon him at the end to enjoy the blessings of eternal life.

In this regard, it might be useful to consider the two criminals crucified either side of Christ. One certainly called upon him, even in his final moments, but the other did not, he refused; indeed he taunted Jesus. One example shows us that even a deathbed conversion is possible, but the other shows us it is not guaranteed.

Christ is worthy of the whole of our lives, not merely the final breath.


